What is Hearing Voices?

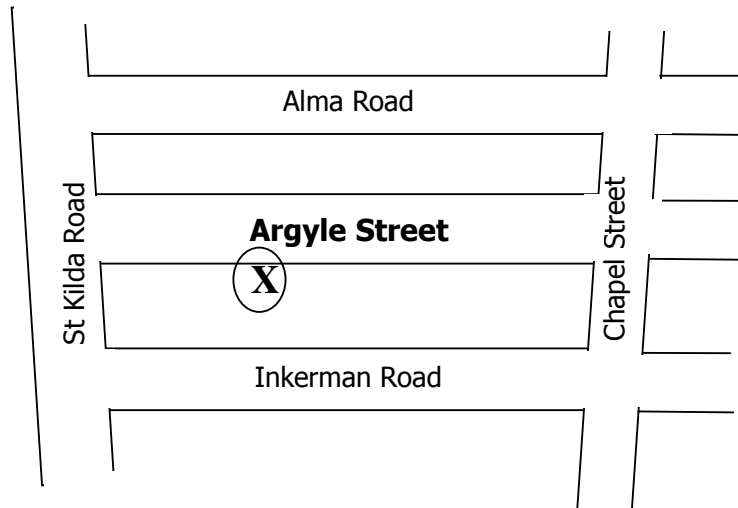
